*** There are currently 13 known private school systems in Virginia with a total of about 5,678 white pupils enrolled. New private school development known to be underway in Nottoway and Appomattox Counties and is suspected in Charlotte, Lunenburg, Greensville, and the Isle of Wight. Information on private schools in Virginia is not easy to come by. Facts about each school are obscured and the State Department of Education either knows little or is reluctant to release any information. Private schools are not required to be accredited in Virginia. They refuse to supply any significant data. The four private schools which are designated as accredited were those which were accredited as of the 1962-63 school year. A few others may have been accredited since.
