## MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OF VISITORS OF VIRGINIA COMMONWEALTH UNIVERSITY

HELD ON MAY 14, 1968

A special meeting of the Executive Committee of the Board of Visitors of Virginia Commonwealth University was held on the 14th day of May, 1968 at 9:30 o'clock in the forenoon in the President's dining room of the Richmond Professional Institute in the City of Richmond, Virginia, pursuant to due notice.

Present were all of the members of the Committee.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the same on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, adjourned.
