Scholars Compass is an open access publishing platform hosted through VCU Libraries. This platform houses the work of faculty, students, and staff, including but not limited to, research, journals, dissertations, and administrative documents.

In the spirit of open access, VCU libraries wish to encourage the use of the repository's resources to include the wider community, especially those serving in local learning environments. In light of the current public health crisis, and the rise in virtual learning, the need for relevant, high-quality, and free digital resources has never been higher.

Scholars Compass has many potential applications for classroom teachers: a source of fresh content, a source of examples to model college-level work for high school students, and an opportunity to connect with a local public university and its community of scholars.
