

### BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL INFORMATION

he Sixth Mount Zion Baptist Church was founded by Reverend John Jasper on September 1867 and was the first church in Richmon organized by an African American. Th congregation originally met in an abandoned horse stable on Brown's Island in the James River. In 1869, the congregation purchased land on Duval Street located in what is now Jackson Ward. The core of the present church building was erected in 1885 by George Boyd. The 1925 remodeling of the church in the Gothic Revival style was done by architect Charles T. Russell and builder I. Lincoln Bailey. The church was listed on the National Register of Historic Places

articles, programs, images, brochures, clippings, and other materials concerning the church, its pastors, and Jackson Ward. Many of the items in the collection are photocopies of material, such as booklets and programs fron various church anniversary celebrations. There are also materials relating to the 19th century, such as John Jasper's sermons, but since secondary sources the date range of the records reflect only the dates of origina materials in the collection.
