# MCV: Richmond's Never-Sleeping Giant

A GIANT constructive force in our Commonwealth, and a huge contributor to the stability and recognition of our capital city, plods on effectively and efficiently 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, in downtown Richmond. Its many past and present contributions, and its potential for the future, are hardly recognized by those it serves — or waits to serve.

Well known nationally and internationally for its outstanding staff and for its contributions to research and innovative surgical procedures, the eminence of our MCV/VCU complex is not really understood by many Richmonders and Virginians.

Few know, for instance, that MCV is the fourth largest health health sciences complex in the nation and that it is the home of the fifteenth largest medical school in the nation. The MCV Hospital, now undergoing \$111 million in improvements, is the second largest university-owned teaching hospital in America, outranked in this category only by the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics.

Most people know that MCV is part of an over-all complex — Virginia Commonwealth University, which the General Assembly established in 1968 as a comprehensive contemporary university serving the state and the nation from downtown Richmond. The combination of the academic campus and the MCV campus served more than 300,000 Virginians in the past school year.

More than 12,500 operations, including some of the most complex procedures — many making worldwide headlines — took place within the year in the 13 operating suites of the vast institution.

Almost 80,000 persons visited MCVH's two emergency rooms during the past year, and hundreds of thousands packed its clinics for treatments ranging from tooth neglect to the most pitiful of terminal illnesses.

In serving the people of Virginia, MCV is pre-eminent. Its 1,058-bed capacity makes MCVH the largest general-care hospital complex in the Old Dominion. Last year, patients came to MCV from every county and city in Virginia. More than half the patients admitted lived outside the Richmond area.

## Economic Impact

It is difficult to separate the figures for employment and payroll at the two campuses of Virginia Commonwealth University. Total employment, faculty and staff, is 9,255; the annual payroll of the college and hospital is \$84 million. Added to these figures is the student population. This income contributes greatly to the tax base of the metropolitan community and, of course, adds to the economic factor that gives the Richmond area a very low unemployment rate and bolsters the retail trade index of the area. Both as to total employment and payroll, the institution ranks among the biggest contributors to Richmond's economic welfare.

The volume of usage of MCVH facilities in a year is staggering: 33,000 patients admitted, 3.3 million clinical pathology tests performed, 114,500 diagnostic pathology tests completed, 490,000 prescriptions dispensed, 19,824 radiation therapy treatments given, and 3,334 babies born.

The cost figures, too, are staggering. For instance, a Blue Cross report says it now costs \$25,000 a year to teach a medical student. And with thousands of highly-trained people required to operate a large medical-hospital complex through three shifts every day, the price of maintaining this essential service is rapidly escalating — with the effect being painfully experienced by both the hospital and patients.

## Leading the Commonwealth

MCV's educational facilities in the health care field lead the Commonwealth in number. MCV is the only Virginia institution of higher education which awards health professional degrees in dentistry, pharmacy, physical therapy, hospital administration and health care management, occupational therapy, and medical technology.

●The MCV School of Medicine graduated more than half of the physicians produced in Virginia last year; one of every three practicing physicians in Virginia is a graduate of MCV. Last year's entering class consisted of 91 per cent Virginians.

●The School of Dentistry has graduated six of every 10 practicing dentists in Virginia; 88 per cent of last year's entering class lived in Virginia.

●The School of Pharmacy has graduated six out of every 10 registered pharmacists in the Commonwealth. This year 100 per cent of the entering class were Virginians.

●MCV's School of Basic Sciences is unchallenged and unequalled in its contributions through research and development. The allied health field is a necessary co-partner in the total care structure of today's health-conscious nation, and MCV is a leader in this field.

MCV is a potent factor in the health care of the Old Dominion and throughout the United States. MCV offers graduate and undergraduate degree programs in 22 health science disciplines. Only the programs at UCLA, the University of Michigan, and the University of Minnesota are known to be larger or more varied.

## Giant Steps Underway

MCV is taking giant steps to meet the challenges of the future — a future where more and more health care will be demanded by the public.

Already overburdened by mounting requests for support of new building projects and upgrading of existing facilities, the state government has responded with as much generosity as possible to the needs of MCV. It is moving to correct the physical conditions in the present MCV Hospitals, where the average age of its five major facilities is 40 years. MCV East, for instance, is 57; MCV South is 74.

The new main MCV Hospital complex, now under construction, will cost an estimated \$86 million; the proposed upgrading of existing buildings will cost an estimated \$25 million. Together, the two projects will give MCV totally modern patient-care facilities for its assigned tasks by 1983.

It is important to note that of the \$111 million required to build and finance the program, \$11 million is coming from state-appropriated tax dollars to MCVH, while the remaining \$100

million (actually \$99.8 million) will be financed from revenue bonds to be sold here in Virginia and nationwide. For the most part, these bonds will not be paid by tax dollars, but rather through revenue generated by MCVH for the services it provides to patients across the Commonwealth.

In the exploding world of health care needs, this may be only an interim program, but it will greatly solve some of the most pressing problems for the foreseeable future in Virginia.

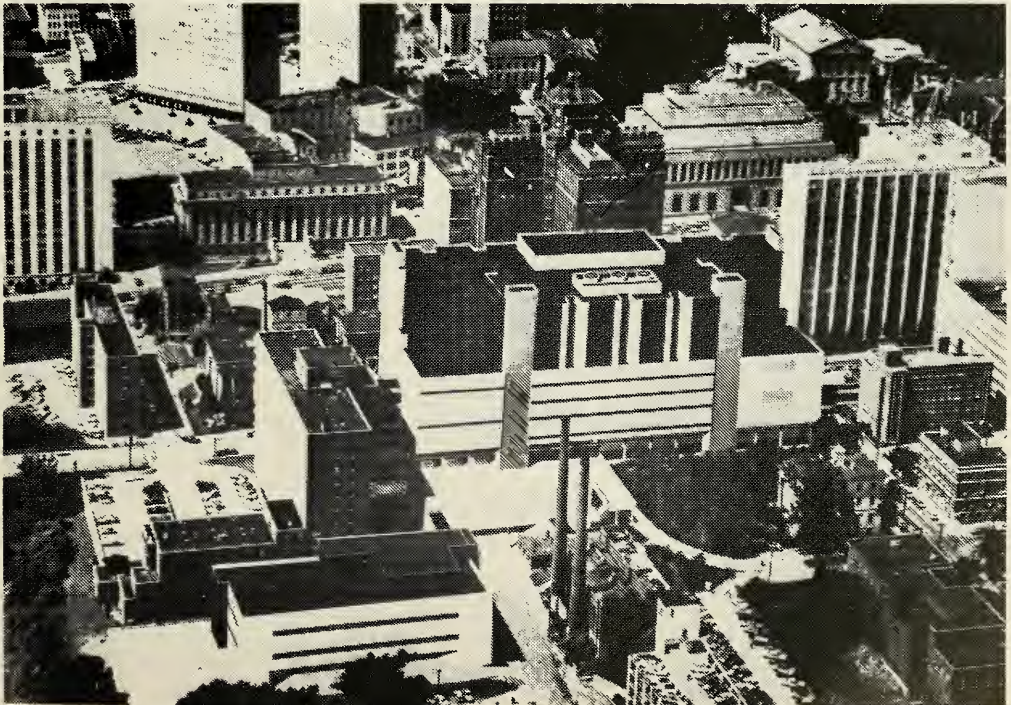
## Foundation Support

MCV has a handmaiden, the MCV Foundation, which seeks to help the Commonwealth in its support of our vastly under-recognized jewel in the health care field. Unfortunately, the MCV Foundation's part in the project is also virtually unknown, even to many of those who are graduates of the institution. It has not been significantly supported by many corporations within the state whose employees benefit from the services offered at MCV. And its outreach never has gone to many

national foundations and corporations whose "social conscience" and public relations funding of such institutions as MCV have been generously funneled to other more aggressive institutions throughout the country and the world.

Government, either federal or state, cannot do it all, and those who stand to benefit should do their part. The MCV Foundation was founded in 1949 as a non-profit, non-stock corporation whose purposes are to "aid, strengthen, and extend in every proper and useful manner the work, services, and objectives of the Medical College of Virginia of Virginia Commonwealth University." Its trustees comprise representatives of the MCV faculty, alumni, VCU, and leading interested citizens of Virginia.

Yet even those who cannot financially assist MCV should do their part by recognizing MCV's outstanding role. The thousands who labor there deserve praise for their dedication to our welfare. We have a never-sleeping giant in downtown Richmond — always there for anyone in need — and it has too long gone unrecognized and unappreciated as one of Virginia's greatest assets.

# MCV Student Body/Alumni Association Relationship

During the 1976-77 school year, I attended the MCV Alumni Association Board meetings in the Alumni House and had the pleasure of meeting the officers and board members. They asked me to write this article to inform you as MCV Alumni of our activities in the Student Government Association and further to indicate ways in which we may improve our communication, contacts, and knowledge of each other in the future.

Briefly, the MCV Student Government Association (SGA) undertook a large list of tasks in 76-77 and brought about meaningful changes for the student body in several important areas:

- (1) We sought and have achieved the return of the Larrick Student Center to the administrative control of the MCV provost operating under a student board to set policy and dispense funds.
- (2) We have greatly improved the number of student representatives in the SGA, distributed meeting minutes to more persons, maintained better attendance, participated actively on more university committees, published more thorough meeting minutes, kept in touch with academic campus student leaders, and maintained personal contact with key university figures to a degree not accomplished in recent years.
- (3) Sponsored a larger variety of social events than ever before, including two dances, five beer blasts, and an outdoor barbeque/dance.
- (4) Begun revision of the SGA constitution.
- (5) Sought and achieved a revision of the annual \$140 Consolidated Fee (down to \$125 now).
- (6) Published a yearbook (\$16,000 budget).
- (7) Included academic students who live in MCV dormitories in SGA sponsored social activities.
- (8) Listened to remarks from the VCU president, the MCV provost, the past-president of the MCV Alumni Association, the MCV dean of Student Life, and the MCV director of athletics in SGA meetings.
- (9) Directly participated through committee membership and public hearings in the revision of the top regulatory policy for VCU, the "Rules and Procedures Document."
- (10) Testified before two Commonwealth of Virginia legislative groups, a legislative subcommittee and the Senate Finance Committee, and corresponded with Governor Godwin seeking funding for the Health Sciences Building.
- (11) Sponsored a student-body blood drive in March (yield over 100 units) and a state-wide Career Day for students across Virginia interested in pursuing a health career (attendance 1,000).
- (12) Studied and approved funding of a junior size olympic swimming pool to be attached to the MCV gymnasium.
- (13) Approved payment of a \$5 inter-collegiate fee per MCV student to match the fee already paid by the west campus students.
- (14) Reviewed and improved the process of selling MCV rings.
- (15) Managed the ordering and delivery of graduation invitations for all seniors.

The above list is not complete but will suffice in portraying the scope of SGA activities. The SGA is composed of one elected representative per each 40 students in the larger classes and one representative for each of the remaining classes to give representation to all classes in the six schools of MCV. As such, it is a unique body in all of VCU since the undergraduate campus has no elected student government.

As a new member of the MCV Alumni Association and now the immediate past president of the MCV student body, I would like to offer a few ideas to improve the alumni/SGA relationship to the benefit of both organizations. First, I feel each new MCV student should receive a written welcome to MCV shortly after registration from the Alumni Association with a brief explanation of alumni interest in the student. Next, each MCV student should receive a copy of *The Scarab* while at MCV. In addition, the Alumni Association president should send a special newsletter to each MCV student during the school year explaining key activities

of the Association so that students will feel as though the Alumni Association is alive and well. A working relationship should be maintained between the Alumni Association Board and the SGA executive committee through several informal get-togethers during each year. The SGA elects new officers each April and contact should be established at that time. The SGA president should continue to attend Association Board meetings to give reports of SGA activities and should give a brief written report in *The Scarab* to all alumni each year. The Association should sponsor several student scholarships and continue to host the graduation dance with the SGA. The Association president should address one SGA meeting each year on Association activities.

By creating a visible and meaningful relationship along the lines suggested above, I feel more students will become Association members and that the SGA will come to see more ways to work with alumni and vice versa. The experience of the Association could play a key role in assisting students to improve MCV. After all, who better knows the MCV system than a former student? The newly resurrected student newsletter, *Skull and Bones*, will now offer immediate improvements in student body awareness and provide opportunities to the MCV Alumni Association to convey their affairs to current MCV students. A SGA vice president is in charge of this newsletter.

Many situations at MCV need improvement and change in order for continued growth and development as an outstanding medical college. As an interested constituent of MCV, your support, ideas, knowledge, and interest can play an important role in this area. I hope these ideas are not put aside with this magazine and that you will do your part to help students improve our alma mater. After all the great majority of them will become alumni shortly and the key factor in the kind of alumni they become is the role you show them through your interest/disinterest and action/inaction.

Editor's Note: The MCV Alumni Association has, in the past, welcomed the students in an invitation to a function in their honor. This year a letter of welcome was sent and a key ring with the MCV seal on one side and the MCV Alumni Association on the other was given each new student as a visible token. *The Scarab* is sent to all the seniors. Our plans are to continue meeting with the SGA Board.

# Lest We Forget

1903—UCM Jennie Pritchett (N) of Richmond, Virginia, died on September 19, 1976.

1911—UCM Emma B. Brook (N) of Lynchburg, Virginia, died on March 25, 1976.

1913 Estill L. Caudill, Sr. (M) of Elizabethton, Tennessee, died on September 3. In 1928, he, his brother, and another doctor established St. Elizabeth Hospital and when it closed, he became the first chief of staff at Carter County Memorial Hospital. Doctor Caudill was a fellow of the American College of Surgeons, a charter member and ruling elder of the Memorial Presbyterian Church, and the organizer and first president of the Carter Chamber of Commerce and the Citizens Bank, the latter of which he was chairman of the board from its inception to his death. He received in 1974 the Governor's Outstanding Tennessean Award. His late brother, W. C., and his son, E. L., Jr., and grandson E. L. III, are graduates of MCV.

1921 Thomas Dewey Davis (M) of Richmond, Virginia, was drowned in a boating accident on July 6. Doctor Davis was a past president of the MCV Alumni Association and a member of its Board for many years. Doctor Davis practiced internal medicine in Richmond until his retirement in 1975. He taught at the College from 1922 to 1965 when he was made emeritus professor of clinical medicine. He was a lifetime fellow of the American College of Physicians and a diplomate of the American Board of Internal

Medicine. He was a past president of the Richmond Academy of Medicine and the Richmond Tuberculosis Association.

1923 John Andrew Mease, Jr. (M), of Dunedin, Florida, died on September 6. Doctor Mease after graduation opened a private practice of medicine and continued to operate two drug stores in Richmond using his previous training in pharmacy. On January 1, 1926, Doctor Mease left Richmond, moving to Dunedin, Florida. Seeing the need for medical care in this west-coastal area, he began planning a hospital and clinic on which construction was begun in 1932. The hospital opened its doors to the public on April 18, 1937. From its original 19-bed, one-doctor size, the hospital and clinic has grown to 312 beds and a 40-physician clinic and by 1980 will total 650 beds and 75 physicians. He established the hospital and clinic as a non-profit corporation governed by a board of trustees on which he served as president until 1969. He then became chairman. Doctor Mease has served as a city commissioner and president and director of the Sons of the American Revolution, as well as in a variety of capacities in other civic and social organizations. In 1947 he became a member of the board of Florida Blue Cross and served until 1969. He envisioned a home for retired citizens in Dunedin and was instrumental in the development of the non-profit Mease Manor corporation—a 423-resident, nine-story apartment complex. He served as president of this corporation since its inception in 1963. He had retired from active practice.

1924 Pauline Meyer Williams (M) of Richmond, Virginia, died on August 14. Doctor Williams joined the faculty of MCV upon graduation as an instructor in pathology. She was appointed an associate professor and dean of women two years later. In 1937, she became a part-time lecturer at MCV and opened a private practice of ophthalmology which she maintained until her retirement. She was a fellow of the American College of Physicians, a past chairman of Women Physicians of the Southern Medical Association, and a past president of Alpha Epsilon Iota, a national women's medical fraternity.

1928 Edna M. Prather (N) of Asheville, North Carolina, died on January 10.

1929 E. H. Goldberg, Jr. (D), of Bennettsville, South Carolina, died on March 3.

1930 Claude E. Simons (M) of Wilson, North Carolina, died on January 6. 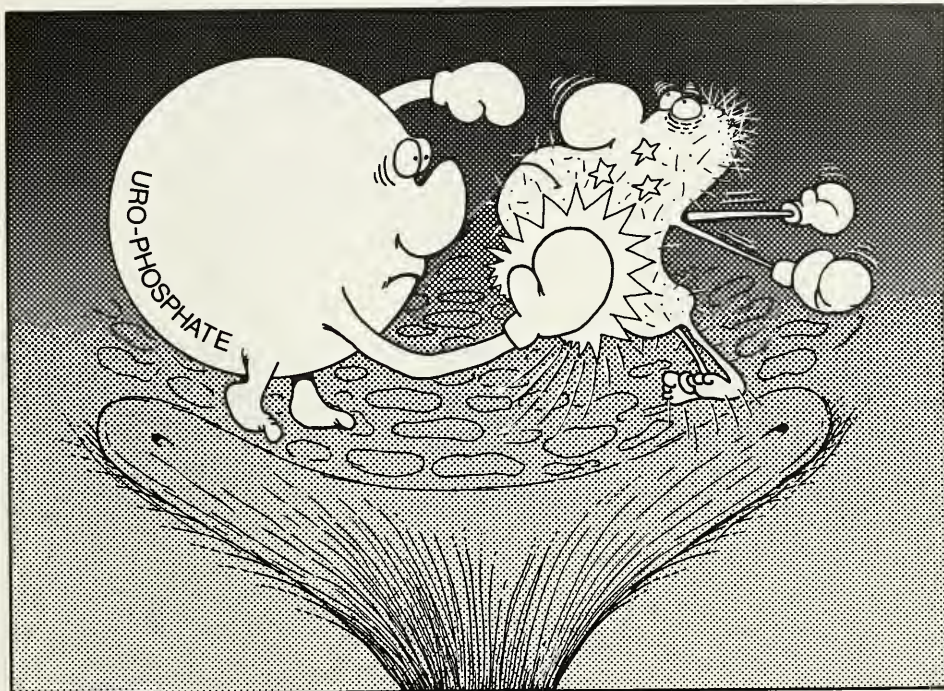

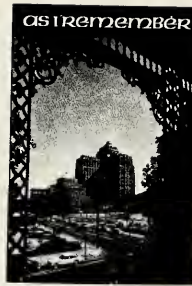
