

# Course scheduling for college is an involved process


- Information Availability- Often, all of the information that a student needs to build a personalized schedule isn't all available in one place (I.E. Course prerequisites, Individual semester availability).
- Access to Advisor Scheduling a meeting with an advisor can be a difficult process for some, such as international students or students that commute long distances.

• **Personalize** - Build a personalized schedule with an intuitive interface based on a drag and drop model. Everything that you need to plan your college career is located on one web page.




 Courses Taken - Enter in the courses that you've already taken and see how they transfer over to the major of your choosing. This will help determine your degree requirements.

- Prioritize Courses Courses are color coded depending on what you are capable of taking in a given semester. These individual blocks can be dragged into the semester cart, which is used to build your schedule. Additional classes will unlock and change colors when you finish scheduling a semester
- Finsure Accuracy Removing a class from the schedule will check and remove any related courses that are reliant on that course as a prerequisite
