Before coming to VCU, Dr. Vlahcevic held faculty appointments at New England Conservatory of Music and Cleveland Institute of Music. Her performances include numerous two-piano recitals, lecture recitals and solo piano concerts. At VCU, she has an active role teaching and advising graduate music students. As Professor of Music, Dr. Vlahcevic teaches piano, music theory, aural skills and analysis for performance.
