Needs Work = Concept is relevant to aims and scope of IJLLAE but is not clearly articulated, gaps in knowledge of the literature; poorly organized, APA style, grammatical and spelling errors. **Major revisions required.**

Unsatisfactory = Poorly articulated and written concept, relevance to aims and scope of IJLLAE unclear; little to no knowledge of scholarly literature; not in APA style; major grammatical and spelling errors. **Reject manuscript.**
